Transport Statement

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1.0 Introduction

1.1 Background

1.1.1 This report has been prepared by JPP Consulting Limited on behalf of Manor Oak Homes to support a detailed planning application for a residential development comprising 12 dwellings with associated highway infrastructure and public open space. The benefit of this report is limited to our instructing Client.

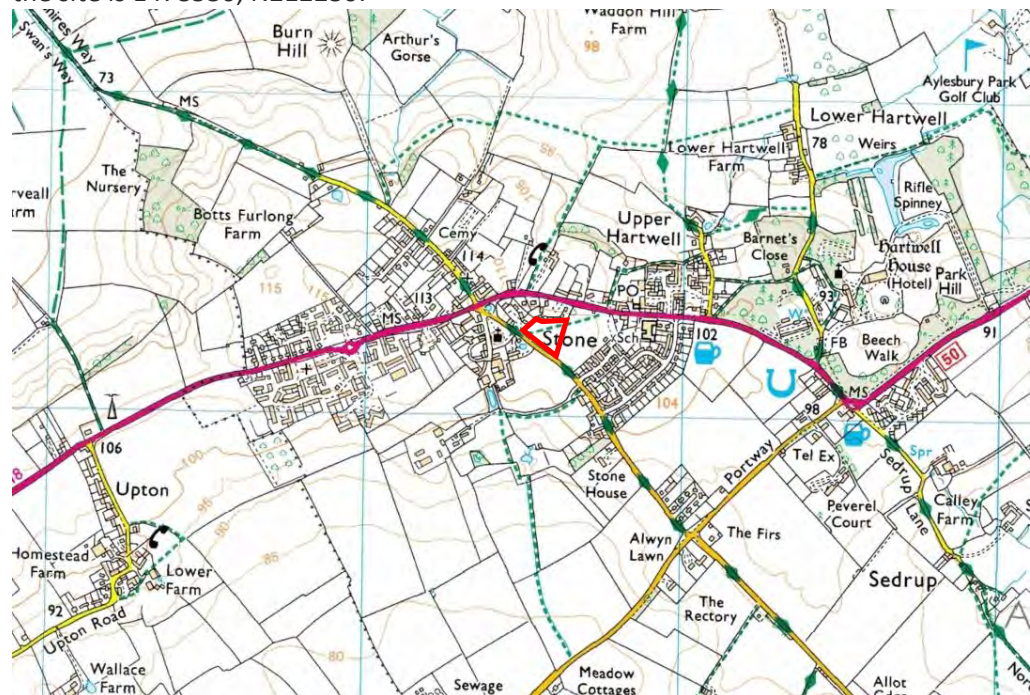


Figure 1: Site Location Plan

1.1.2 The proposed residential development is located at land off Bishopstone Road, Stone, Buckinghamshire, as shown on the location plan in Figure 1 and enclosed in Appendix A. Stone is located on the A418 to the west of Aylesbury. The proposed development has a total development area of 0.973ha (9,725m²). The National Grid reference for the site is E478530, N212230.

1.2 Scope of Assessment

1.2.1 The aim of the Transport Statement is to support a detailed planning application for a residential development comprising 12 dwellings. The proposed development layout is shown on the drawing enclosed in Appendix B.

1.2.2 This report will consider the wider highway network implications of the new development and will also focus on the sustainable credentials of the development.

2.0 Site Description and Development Proposals

2.1 Site Location

2.1.1 The proposed residential development is located at land off Bishopstone Road, Stone, as shown on the location plan in Figure 1 and enclosed in Appendix A. The proposed development is bound by existing residential developments to the north and north west, sports pitches to the east and Bishopstone Road to the south and south west.

2.2 Development Description

2.2.1 The proposed development will comprise 12 residential dwellings with associated highway infrastructure and public open space. The existing public right of way through the top of the site will be maintained. The proposed development layout is shown on the plan enclosed in Appendix B.

2.2.2 The adopted road within the development will comprise 4.8m wide carriageway with 2 x 2m wide footways.

2.3 Vehicular Access

2.3.1 The proposed residential development will be accessed off Bishopstone Road via a simple priority junction, as shown on the drawing enclosed in Appendix B.

2.4 Pedestrian and Cycle Access

2.4.1 The development will provide a pedestrian and cycle access via the site's main access to Bishopstone Road along the site's south west boundary.

2.5 Parking

2.5.1 Car and cycle parking for the development will be provided generally in line with Supplementary Planning Guidance 1: Parking Guidelines included in the Aylesbury Vale District Local Plan published in April 2002.

2.6 Planning Background

2.6.1 The site is undeveloped and currently a grass paddock.

3.0 Existing Conditions

3.1 Road Network

- 3.1.1 The existing local highway infrastructure is shown on the plan enclosed in Appendix C.
- 3.1.2 The proposed development will be accessed off Bishopstone Road, which has a width of 5.0m within the vicinity of the site. Bishopstone Road links the proposed development with the A418, which in turn provides connections to Aylesbury to the east and the M40 to the west.
- 3.1.3 Bishopstone Road is subject to a 30mph speed limit within the vicinity of the site.

3.2 Pedestrian Facilities

- 3.2.1 Bishopstone Road is bound by a 1.2m to 1.7m wide footway to the north of the carriageway, adjacent to the site's south western boundary.
- 3.2.2 A public footpath traverses the site from the western corner to the north eastern corner. The route of this footpath will be maintained through the development and a diversion will not be required.
- 3.2.3 Walking distances and the proximity of key facilities is shown on the plan enclosed in Appendix C.

3.3 Cycle Facilities

- 3.3.1 Gemstone Cycleways *Pebble Way* cycle route follows the A418 / Oxford Road between Stone and Aylesbury along a shared pedestrian / cycle route, see Appendix E. This cycle route can be accessed via Bishopstone Road which connects the proposed development with the A418 / Oxford Road.
- 3.3.2 Cycling distances and the proximity of key facilities is shown on the plan enclosed in Appendix C.

3.4 Public Transport

3.4.1 Bus

- 3.4.1.1 The nearest existing bus stops for the proposed development are located on the A418 Oxford Road, approximately 350m from the proposed site entrance. The location of the existing bus stops are shown on the facilities plan enclosed in Appendix C.
- 3.4.1.2 General bus service frequencies and routes of buses utilising the Oxford Road bus stops are set out in Table 3.1 below. Full time table and bus route information is enclosed in Appendix D. The information provided in the tables below and the appendices was correct at the time of publication.

3.4.1.3 Collectively, the 110 / 111 / 280 bus routes will provide residents with a regular Monday to Saturday bus service to Aylesbury, Oxford and Worminghall, in addition to many stops on route, therefore providing commuters with a sustainable alternative to the private car for work and leisure trips.

3.4.1.4 The 613 bus route is a school bus with two services in the morning and one in the afternoon, which runs during term time only, therefore providing a sustainable form of transport to education.

3.4.2 Rail

3.4.2.1 The nearest railway station is Aylesbury, located approximately 5.0km (3.1miles) from the proposed development. The railway station is located on the line from London Marylebone to Aylesbury Vale Parkway, and is also served by local services between Aylesbury and Princes Risborough. The station is served by trains to London Marylebone every 30 minutes, in addition to many stations on route, including Wendover, Amersham, Chorleywood and Rickmansworth.

3.4.2.2 The railway station can be accessed from the proposed site via a multi-modal route: walking to the bus stop on Oxford Road located approximately 350m from the site entrance, taking the 110 / 280 bus service to Aylesbury Bus Station and then walking less than 200m to Aylesbury Railway Station. This will offer opportunities for commuters making long distance journeys to travel by more sustainable forms of transport. Further, the railway station is located within 5km of the site and is therefore within a suitable cycling distance.

3.5 Summary

- 3.5.1 The proposed residential development is located at land off Bishopstone Road, Stone, Buckinghamshire. The proposed residential development will be accessed off Bishopstone Road.
- 3.5.2 The proposed development has good links to the existing walking and cycling infrastructure.
- 3.5.3 The nearest bus stop to the development is served by a regular Monday to Saturday bus service to Aylesbury, Oxford and Worminghall. These buses will offer residents of the development the opportunity to travel via more sustainable forms of transport for work and leisure trips.
- 3.5.4 The nearest railway station is located approximately 5.0km (3.1miles) from the proposed development at Aylesbury. The railway station is located on the line between London Marylebone Aylesbury Vale Parkway, and on the local line between Aylesbury Vale Parkway and Princes Risborough. The station is served by trains to London Marylebone every 30 minutes, in addition to many stations on route, including Wendover, Amersham, Chorleywood and Rickmansworth.

4.0 Accessibility

4.1 Introduction

4.1.1 Planning policy highlights the need for need for sustainable developments to have good accessibility to education, health facilities, employment, leisure and retail. Paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework states ‘Where practical, particularly within large scale developments, key facilities such as primary schools and local shops should be located within walking distance of most properties’.

4.1.2 This section therefore considers the accessibility from the development, by modes of sustainable transport to local facilities including education, health services, employment, leisure and retail. A plan showing the location of key local facilities local to the development site is enclosed in Appendix C.

4.1.3 Walking

4.1.3.1 With reference to the Chartered Institution of Highways and Transportation (CIHT) publication ‘Guidelines for Providing for Journeys on Foot’ (2000), it is suggested that around 80% of walk journeys and walk stages are less than 1 mile (1610m). This guidance also provides ‘suggested acceptable walking distances’ which are set out in Table 4.1 below.

4.1.3.2 Indicative walking time calculations have been calculated assuming a ‘typical’ walking speed of approximately 1.4m/s or 3mph. These are shown against the suggested walking distances set out in Table 4.1 below.

4.1.3.3 A plan showing local facilities and walking distances is enclosed in Appendix C.

4.1.4 Cycling

4.1.4.1 Section 3.10 of the Local Transport note 01/04 states that generally a 4km cycle distance is considered acceptable.

4.1.4.2 Assuming a cycling speed of 12kph the maximum accepted time for a cycling journey is 20mins.

4.1.4.3 A plan showing the location of key local facilities local to the development site is enclosed in Appendix C. It can be seen that there are minimal facilities within a 1.0km radial distance from the proposed development’s access.

4.2 Accessibility to Education

- 4.2.1 The proposed development is located within approximately 0.75km (0.5 miles) walking distance of the nearest existing primary school, Stone C of E Combined School, which is located on Oxford Road. This is within acceptable walking distance for school journeys, as set out in Table 4.1 above.
- 4.2.2 The nearest secondary school, The Grange School, is located on Wendover Way in Aylesbury, approximately 6.3km (3.9 miles) from the proposed development. The Grange School can be accessed from the proposed site via a multi-modal route: walking to the bus stop on Oxford Road located approximately 350m from the site entrance, taking the 110 / 280 bus service to Aylesbury bus station and then walking 1.5km (0.9 miles).
- 4.2.4 The proposed development is shown to be located within acceptable walking and cycling distance of primary education. Secondary education can be accessed via a multi-modal route, utilising the local bus services.

4.3 Accessibility to Health

- 4.3.1 The nearest doctors' surgery is Fairford Leys Surgery located in Aylesbury, approximately 3.8km (2.4miles) from the proposed development. The location of the doctors' surgery is an acceptable cycling distance from the site, and can be accessed using the existing highway infrastructure. The doctors' surgery can also be accessed via a multi-modal route: walking to the bus stop on Oxford Road located approximately 350m from the site entrance, taking the 110 / 280 bus service to the Churchill Avenue bus stop on Oxford Road in Aylesbury, then taking the 1 bus service from the Churchill Avenue bus stop to Fairford Leys Way, followed by a 250m (0.2 mile) walk to the surgery.
- 4.3.2 The nearest hospital is Stoke Mandeville Hospital in Aylesbury, located approximately 6.5km (4.0 miles) from the proposed development. The hospital can be accessed via a multi-modal route: walking to the bus stop on Oxford Road located approximately 350m from the site entrance, taking the 110 / 280 bus service to the Aylesbury College bus stop and then taking the 9 bus service from the Aylesbury College bus stop direct to the hospital
- 4.3.3 The nearest dentist is Eastgate Dental Centre located in Aylesbury, approximately 3.9km (2.4km) from the proposed development. The location of the doctors' surgery is an acceptable cycling distance from the site, and can be accessed using the existing highway infrastructure. The dentist can also be accessed via a multi-modal route: walking to the bus stop on Oxford Road located approximately 350m from the site entrance, taking the 110 / 280 bus service to the Pearson Close bus stop in Aylesbury, followed by a 1.0km (0.6 mile) walk to the dentist.
- 4.3.4 The nearest pharmacy is located in Aylesbury, next to the Fairford Leys Surgery, approximately 3.8km (2.4 miles) from the proposed development. The location of the pharmacy is an acceptable cycling distance from the site, and can be accessed using the existing highway infrastructure. The pharmacy can also be accessed via a multi-

modal route: walking to the bus stop on Oxford Road located approximately 350m from the site entrance, taking the 110 / 280 bus service to the Churchill Avenue bus stop on Oxford Road in Aylesbury, then taking the 1 bus service from the Churchill Avenue bus stop to Fairford Leys Way, followed by a 250m (0.2 mile) walk to the pharmacy.

- 4.3.5 The proposed development is shown to be located within acceptable cycling distances of health services. The health services can also be accessed via a multi-modal route, utilising the local bus services.

4.4 Accessibility to Retail and Leisure

- 4.4.1 The proposed development site is located within cycling distance of Aylesbury. The proposed development is also within close proximity of regular bus services which provide connections to shopping and leisure opportunities in Aylesbury, Oxford and Worminghall, amongst other locations.

- 4.4.2 The proposed development is shown to be located within acceptable cycling and public transport distances of retail and leisure services.

4.5 Accessibility to Employment

- 4.5.1 The development site is located within cycling distance of Aylesbury. The proposed development is also within close proximity of regular bus services which provide connections to employment opportunities in Aylesbury, Oxford and Worminghall, amongst other locations.

- 4.5.2 The proposed development is shown to be located within suitable cycling and public transport distances of employment opportunities.

5.0 Vehicle Trip Impact

5.1 The proposed development will comprise 12 residential dwellings. Person trip generation rates have been obtained from the TRICS database version 7.1.2. The TRICS data is enclosed in Appendix F. Person trip rates are shown in Table 5.1 below.

5.2 From the above person trip rates the number of person trips for the proposed development can be calculated based on a development size of 12 dwellings. The predicted person trip numbers from the proposed development are set out in Table 5.2 below.

5.3 To predict the number of trips generated by mode of transport, travel to work data has been obtained from the 2011 Census for the Haddenham ward which the proposed development is located within. The journey to work data is shown in Table 5.3 below.

5.4 Using the above modal split information it is possible to predict the number of trips from the development made using all forms of transport. Whilst the data does not reflect the fact that not all peak period trips are made to work it offers a good reflection of the actual circumstances. The predicted number of trips by mode from the proposed development is set out in Table 5.4 below.

- 5.5 The proposed development is predicted to generate 14 new vehicle trips in the morning peak period and 12 new trips during the evening peak period. This equates to one new vehicle trip every 4m10s and 5m11s in the morning and evening peak period respectively. This level of new vehicle trips is unlikely to be noticeable above daily fluctuations in background traffic.
- 5.6 We do not consider that this small number of new vehicle trips will result in a significant adverse impact on the surrounding highway infrastructure.

6.0 Conclusions

- 6.1 The proposed residential development is located at land off Bishopstone Road, Stone, Buckinghamshire. The proposed development is bound by existing residential developments to the north and north west, sports pitches to the east and Bishopstone Road to the south and south west.
- 6.2 The proposed development will comprise up to 12 dwellings with associated highway infrastructure and public open space.
- 6.3 The proposed development is shown to be well served and accessible to more sustainable modes of transport. The proposed development has good accessibility to education, health, employment, retail and leisure facilities.
- 6.4 The proposed development will be accessed off Bishopstone Road via a simple priority junction.
- 6.5 There are therefore no reasons on highway grounds why planning permission for the present development should not be granted.

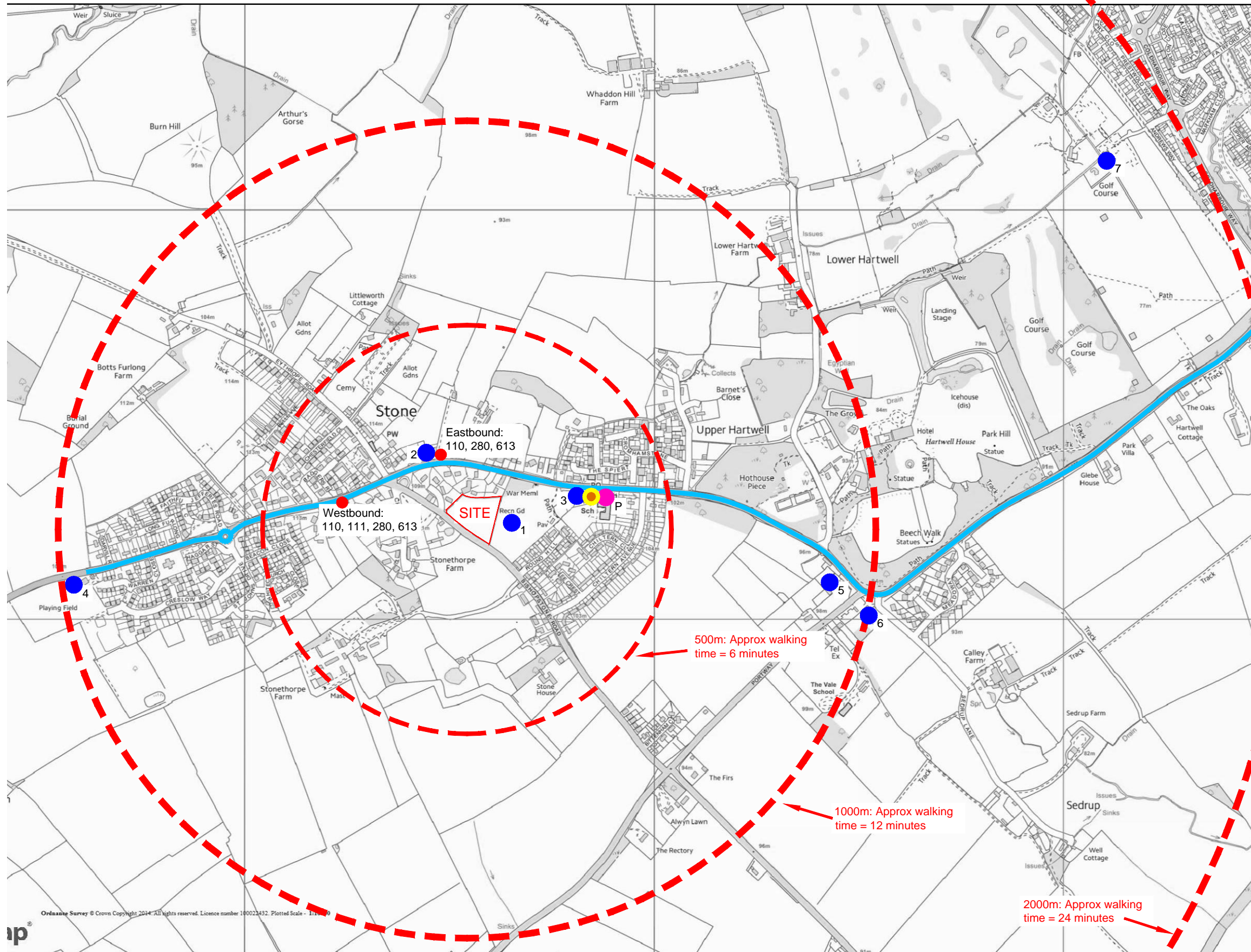

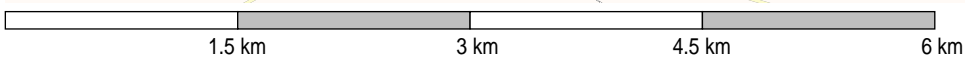
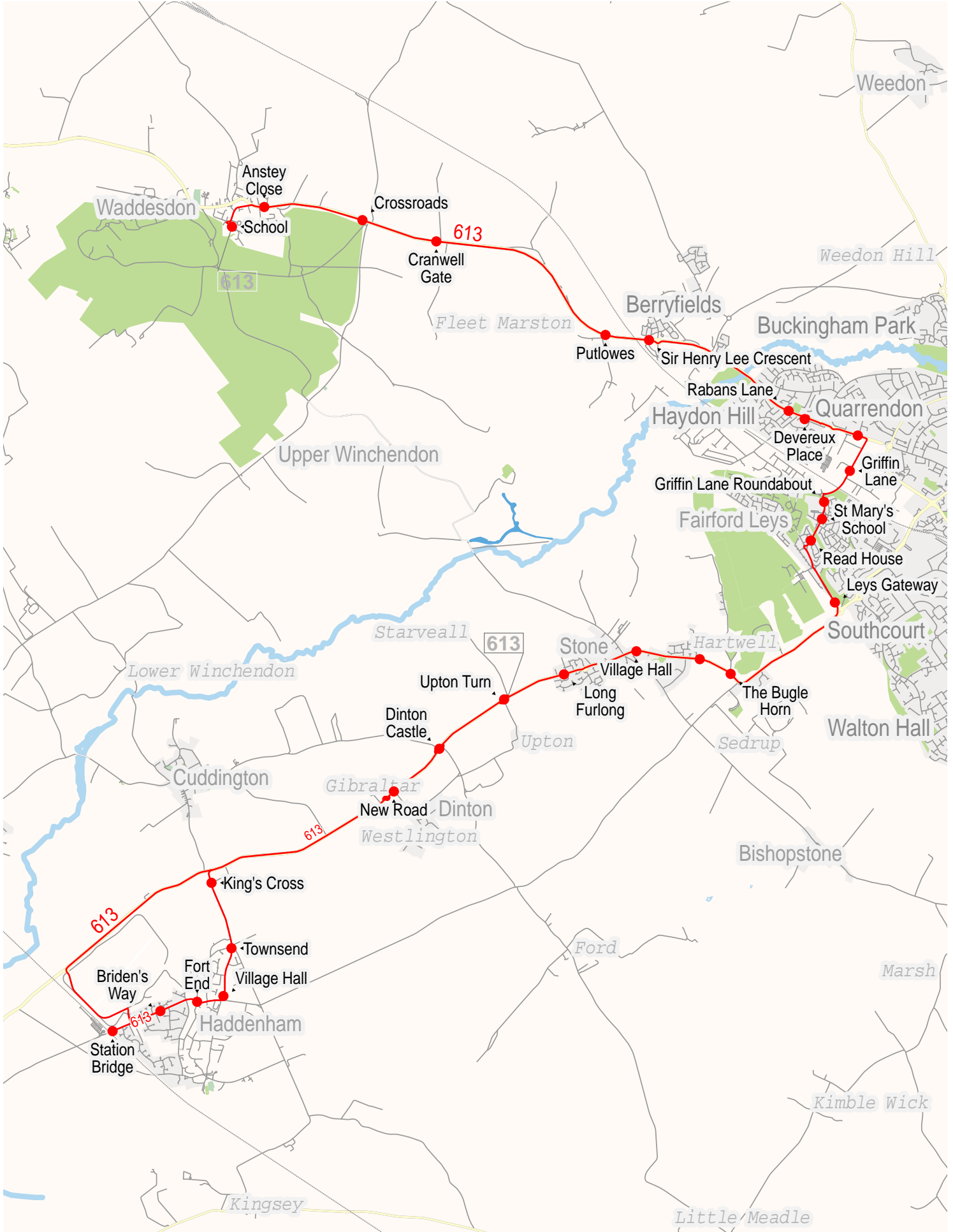
For times of the next departures from a particular stop you can use **traveline-txt** - by sending the SMS code to **84268**. Add the service number after the code if you just want a specific service - eg: **buctdgt 60**. The return message from **traveline-txt** will show the next three departures, and it currently costs 25p plus any message sending charge. However it is free for all stops in Lincolnshire & in the SW region. Departure times will be real-time predictions where available, or scheduled departure times if not.

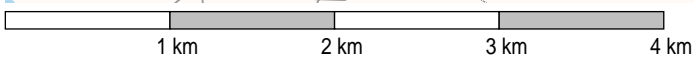
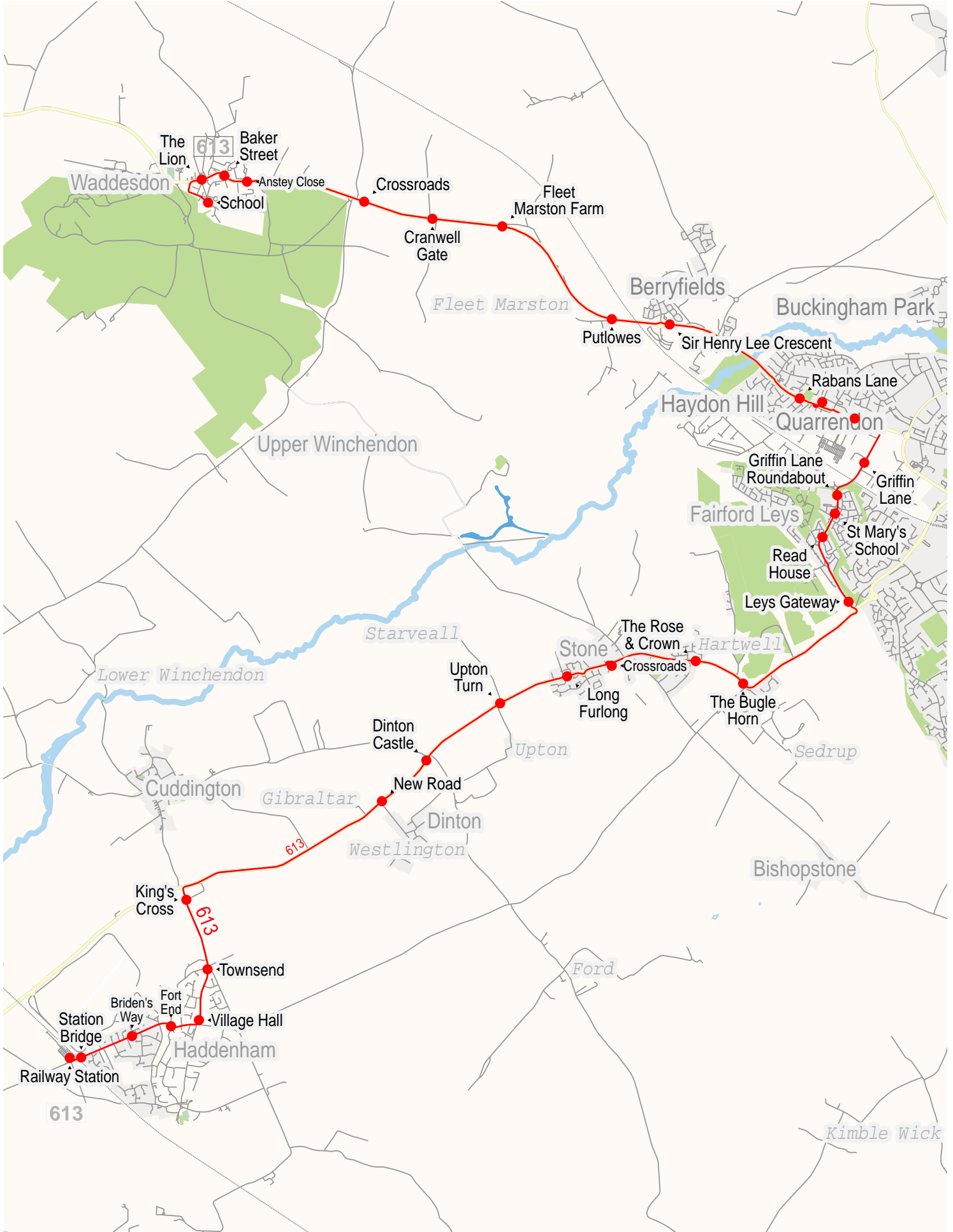

Cycle Routes

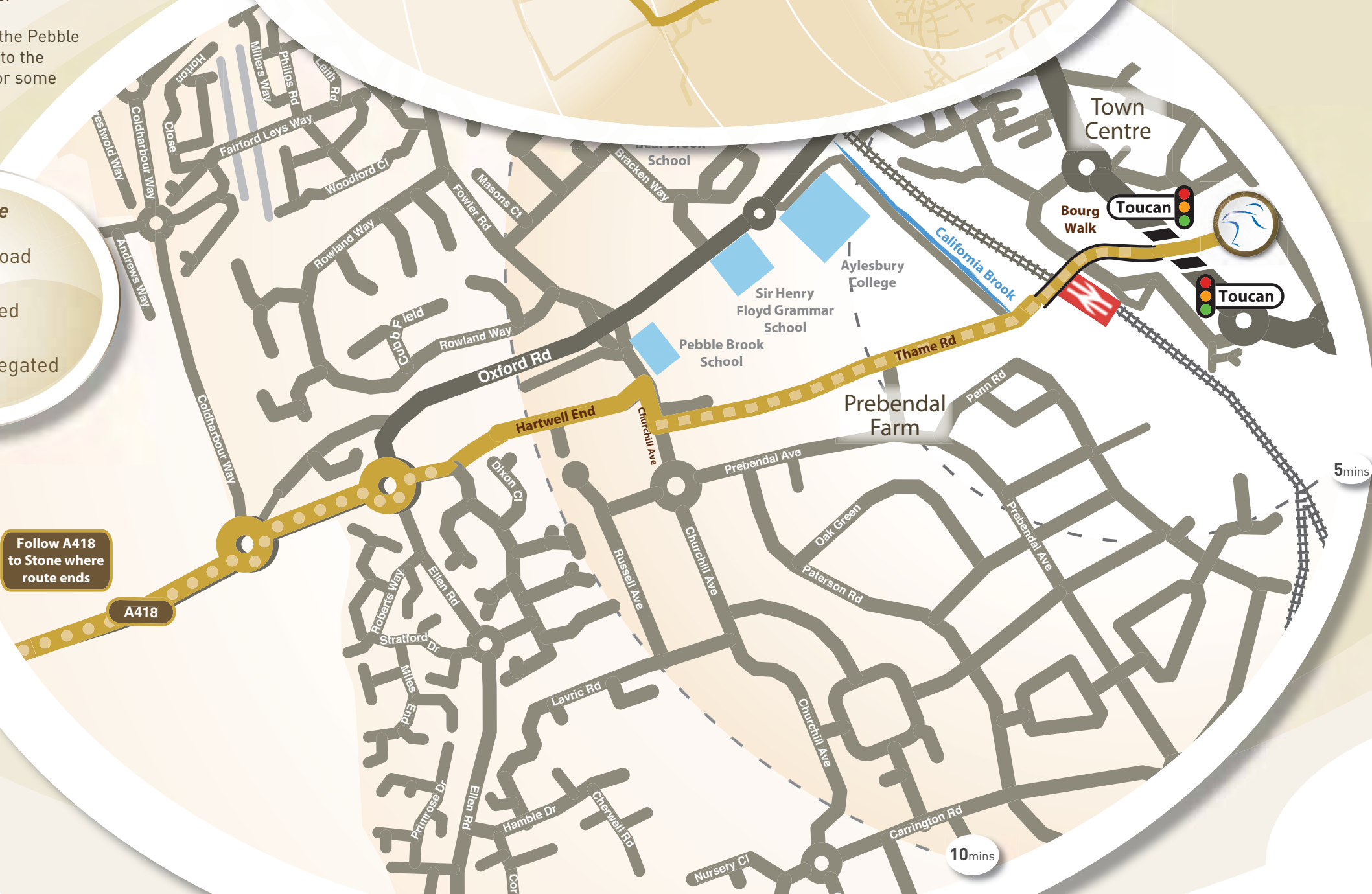
The Pebble Way provides a direct route between Stone and the town centre. The route crosses the Bourg Walk Bridge, providing easy access to Aylesbury Train Station and the town centre.

One of our longest routes, the Pebble Way provides a cycle route to the Bugle Horn public house for some well earned refreshment.

Cycle Aylesbury have made a number of improvements to the continuity and profile of the Gemstone cycle network.

Red surfacing has been applied across roads to show the continuation of the cycle ways. Red surfacing lets drivers see cyclists and pedestrians approaching. It is hoped that motorists will be more considerate and allow them to cross when they are waiting. The red surfacing does not provide increased priority for cyclists but it does show that a crossing is approaching. The 'SLOW' markings and Give Way triangles on the cycle ways make it clear to cyclists that they are approaching a crossing and that they will need to take care as they cross the road.

Cycle Aylesbury

Aylesbury is one of the original 6 national Cycling Towns working towards the Cycling England vision of 'more people cycling, more safely, more often.'

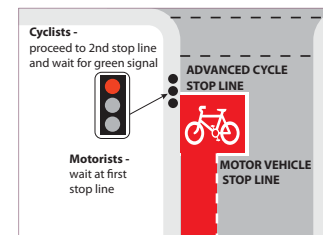

A number of traffic signal controlled junctions in the town have advanced stop lines for cyclists. They enable cyclists to get to the front of traffic queues and improve safety, particularly when turning.



Cycling Tips

Cycling in Aylesbury is easier than ever with on-road cycle lanes and off-road cycle paths. Here are some tips to ensure your journeys are safe and enjoyable.

- Wear a helmet (with a British Standard) - ensure it is a good fit.
- Use lights at night - front and rear.
- Know your route. Avoid difficult situations, such as right turns on busy roads. Choose cycle paths or advisory routes where possible.
- Wear reflective or fluorescent clothing for extra visibility
- Use a good lock (as a guide, a lock should cost about 7-10 % of the value of your bicycle).
- For added security, make sure your bike is easily identifiable. Make a note of the frame number, model, colour and accessories - take a photograph.
- Keep your bike well serviced, check brakes, steering and tyres regularly.
- Ensure children are well trained; if you are an adult set a good example.

Pavement Rules

- On shared routes pedestrians may not be aware of your approach so be courteous, slow down, ring your bell and give them plenty of space. They may be hard of hearing or have bad eyesight.
- It is illegal to cycle on the footway unless it is specifically marked for cyclists.
- Cyclists should give way to pedestrians on shared paths.

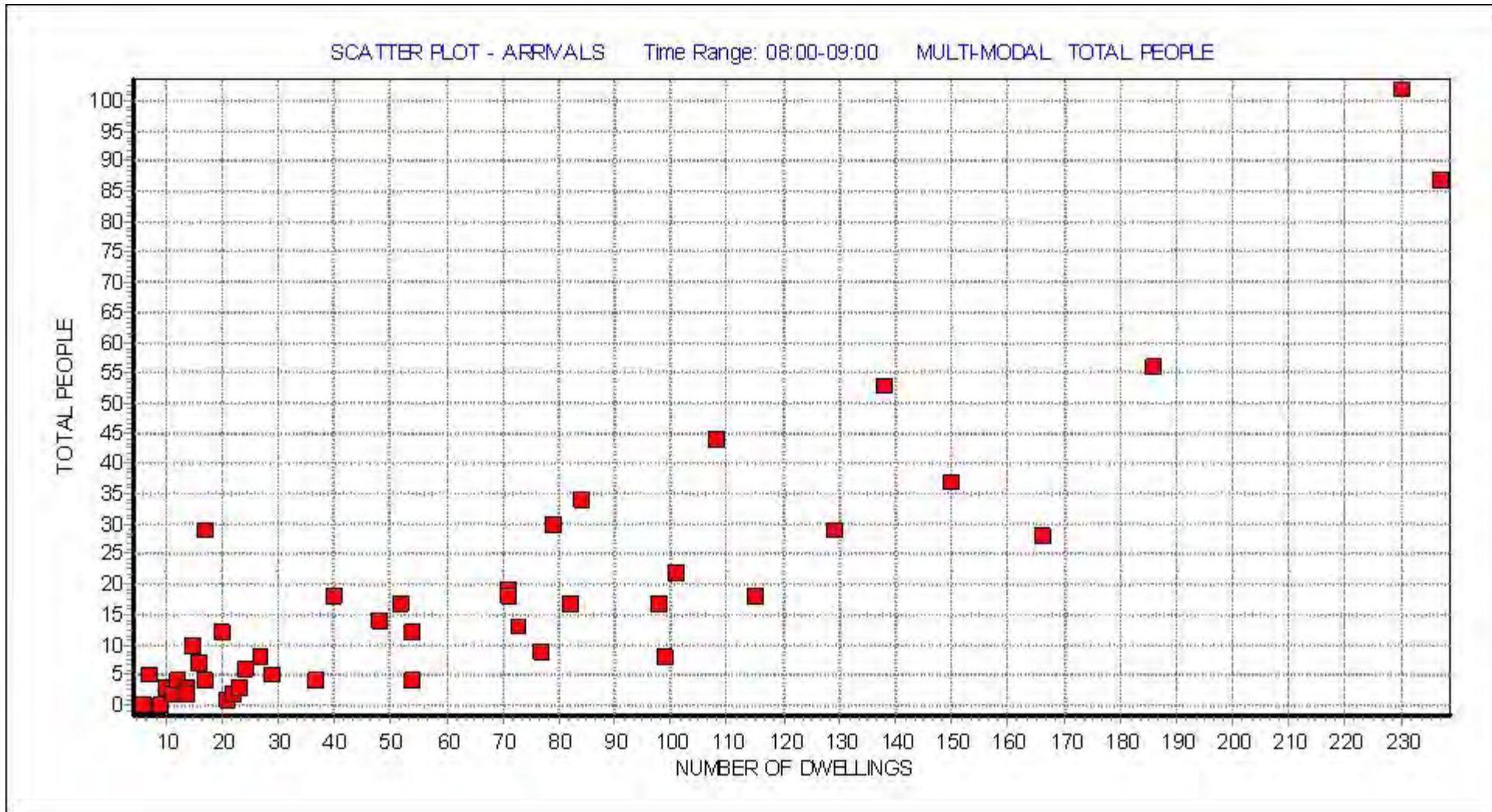

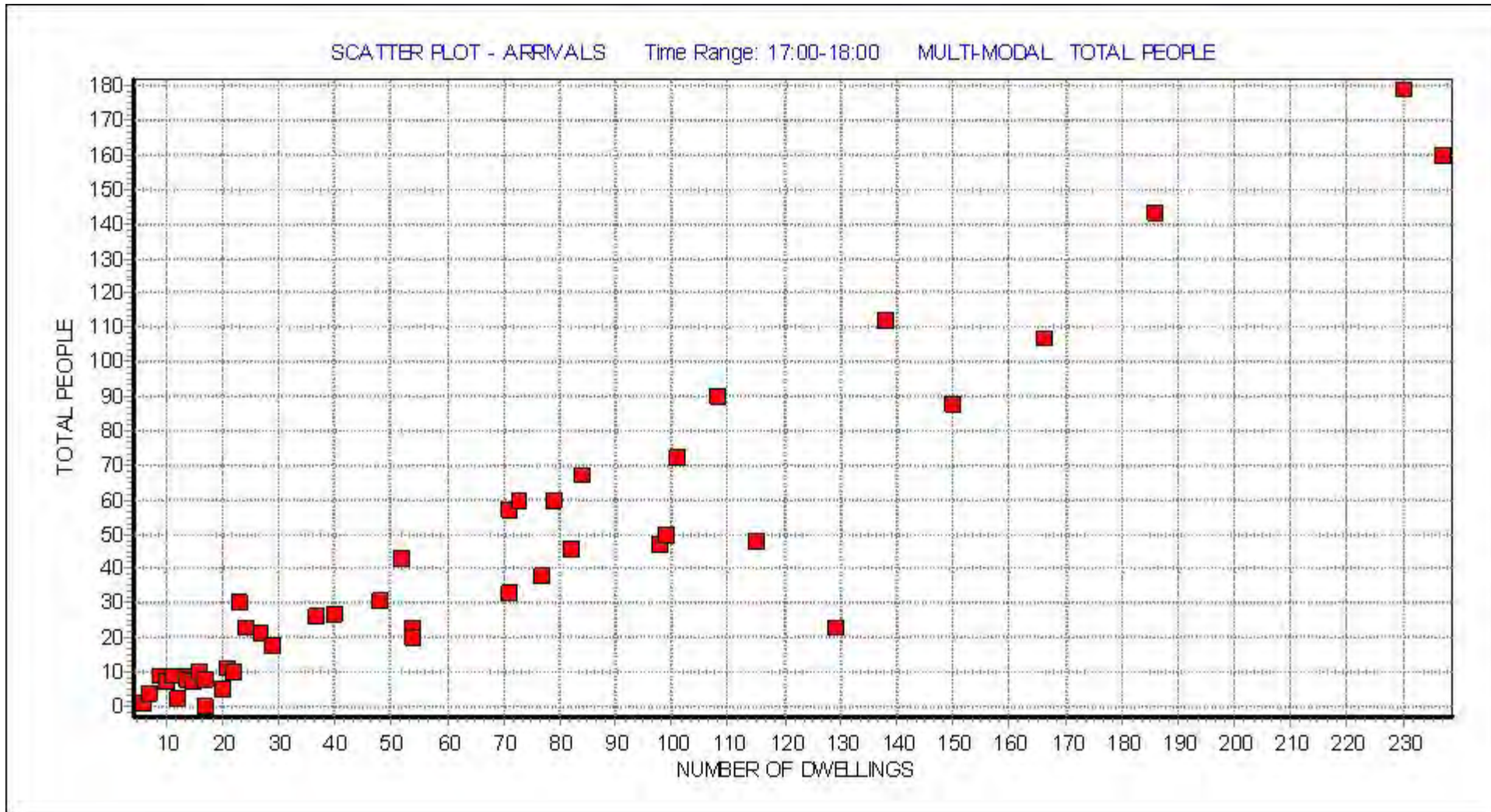

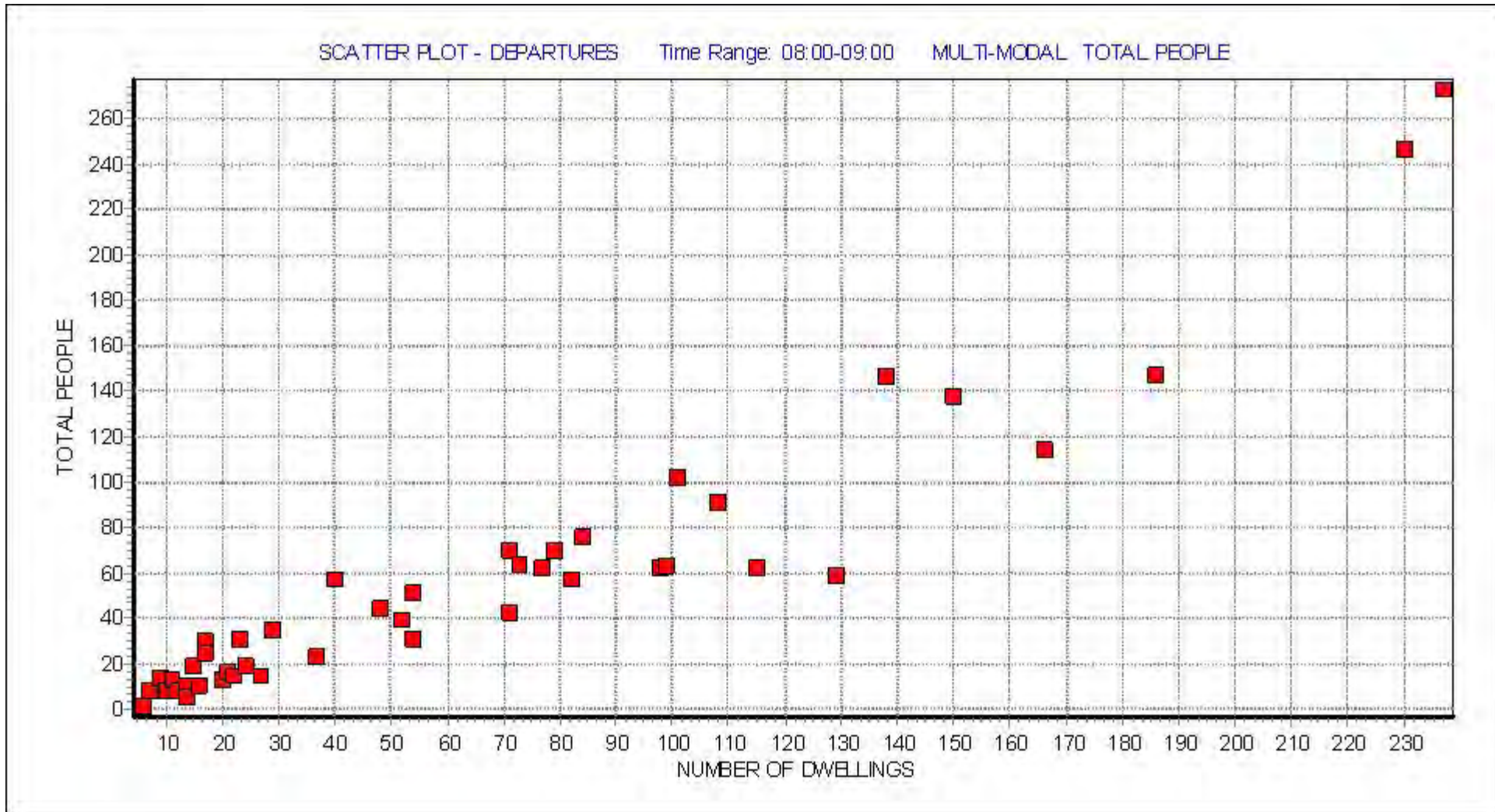

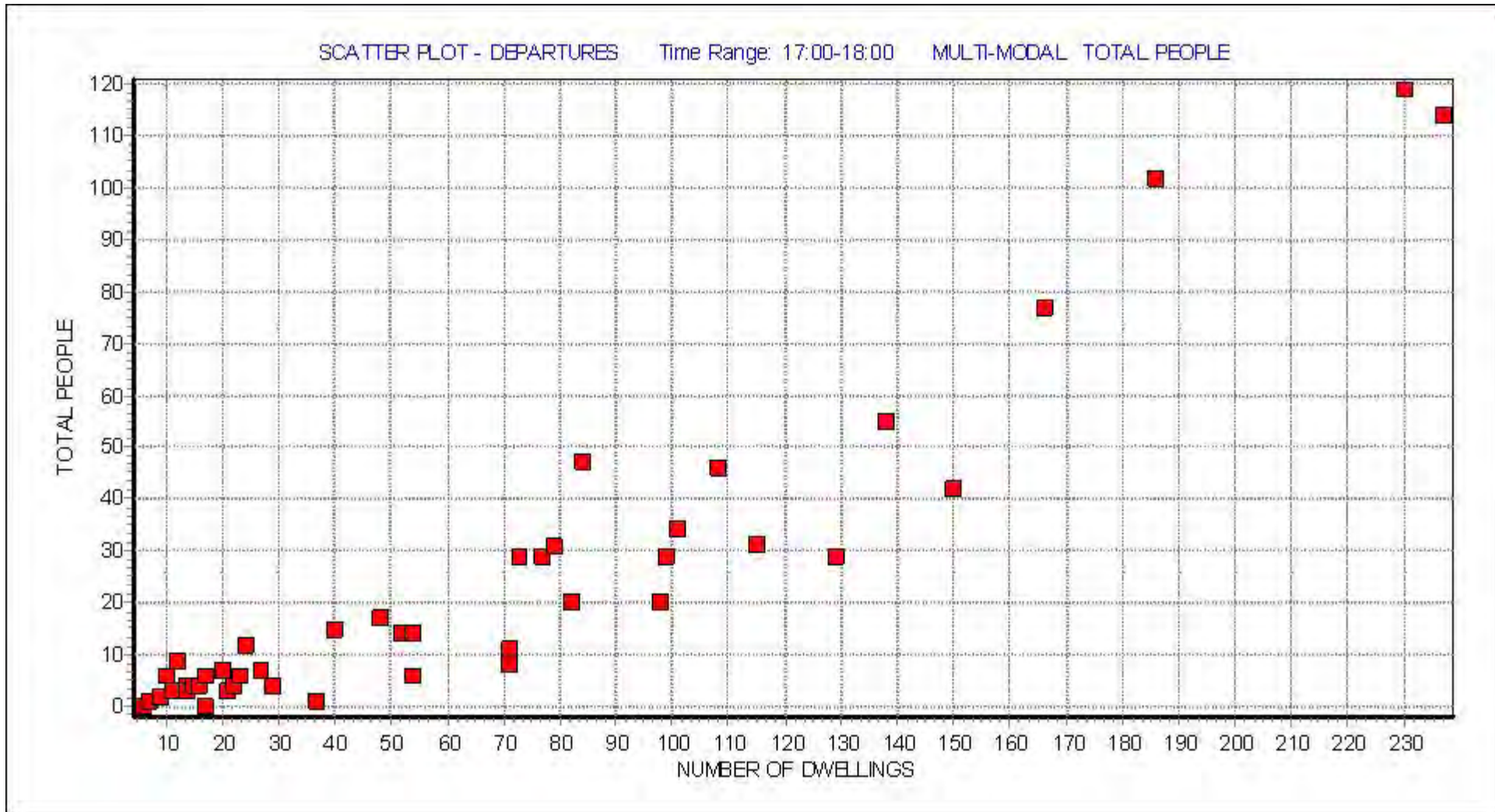

This section displays actual (not average) trip rates for each of the survey days in the selected set, and ranks them in order of relative trip rate intensity, for a given time period (or peak period irrespective of time) selected by the user. The count type and direction are both displayed just above the table, along with the rows within the table representing the 85th and 15th percentile trip rate figures (highlighted in bold within the table itself).

The table itself displays details of each individual survey, alongside arrivals, departures and totals trip rates, sorted by whichever of the three directional options has been chosen by the user. As with the preceding trip rate calculation results table, the trip rates shown are per the calculation factor (e.g. per 100m2 GFA, per employee, per hectare, etc). Note that if the peak period option has been selected (as opposed to a specific chosen time period), the peak period for each individual survey day in the table is also displayed.



This graph is a visual representation of the correlation between the selected trip rate calculation parameter and the rank order trip rates generated by each individual survey day in the selected set. The range of the trip rate parameter is shown along the x axis, with the level of trips shown on the y axis. The selected time range used to create the rank order list from which the graph is derived is displayed at the top of the graph (unless the peak period irrespective of time range has been selected). A line of best fit is sometimes displayed in the graph, should it be selected for inclusion by the user.
